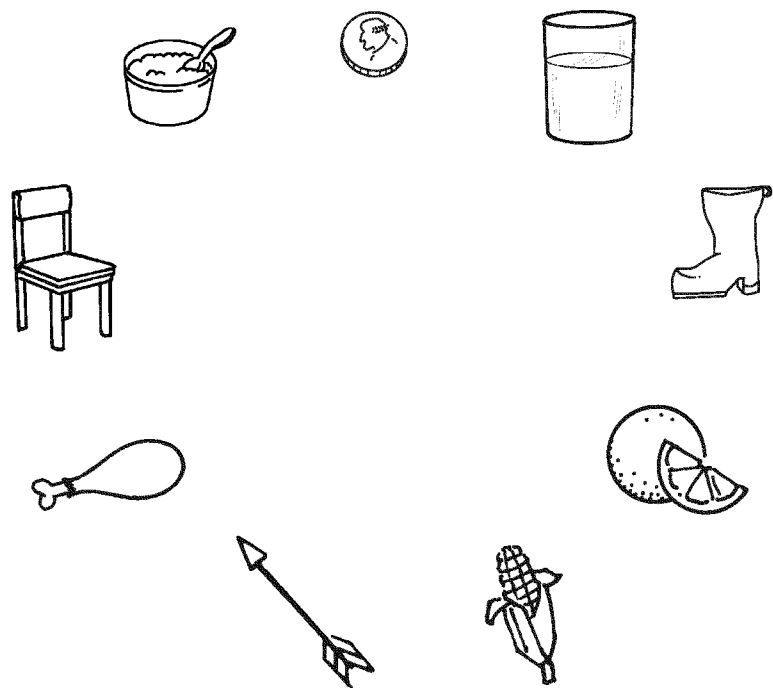


When the king of Israel saw the soldiers, he asked if he should kill them. Elisha said not to kill them, but to give them food and water and send them back to their master.

So the king of Israel gave them a great feast and sent them home. After that, Aram stopped attacking Israel. Elisha had put an end to the war.

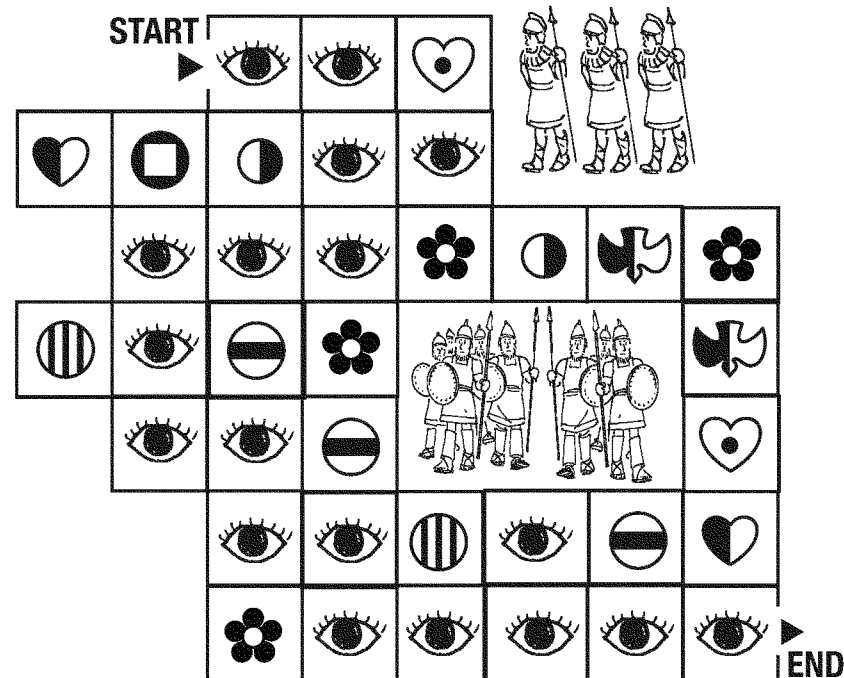
