

Board of Trustees Minutes April 16, 2024 (abridged)

Meeting called to order by Kay at 5:30 pm. Present: Kay, Shawn, Sandra, Lyn, Dennis, Dick, Carol, and Pastor Chuck

Opening Prayer by Pastor Chuck

Minutes of March 11, 2024 meeting were read and approved as presented.

Financial Reports were presented by Kay. An increase in deposits reflected 5 Sundays including Easter. There were 2 payments in the month from St. Onge. Expenses were down for the month and expenses are under budget for the first quarter of 2024. Motion by Dick, 2nd Lyn to approve the financial reports. Motion approved.

Old Business:

The south door into the education building needs new weatherstripping. A 3-piece replacement kit will be purchased and installed.

Discussed the 5 trees on the parkway. Kay will get a firm estimate from John Carbajal once the trees begin to bud and leaf out. Motion by Dennis, 2nd Lyn to authorize Kay to call to get on John's schedule and to negotiate the price up to \$1000.00. Motion approved.

Kay reported that the hail damage on the metal flashing on the flat roof of the education building has not been repaired by the roofing contractor. Also discussed a leak that occurred above the organ due to ice under the flashing.

Continued to discuss resurfacing the front steps. Kay will talk to Kevin Fuhrer to get his input regarding contractors and appropriate materials.

New Business:

Pastor Chuck reported the West River Mental Health, a non-profit, grant-funded professional counselling organization, has been using the comfort room as a safe space for their therapist to meet with students and families. Their director is requesting a Memorandum of Understanding stating that they are secondary users of the space and bear responsibility for liability. Motion by Dick, 2nd Sandra to authorize Kay to act as the church's representative and sign the Memorandum of Understanding. Motion approved.

Discussion continued regarding the church sign on the front lawn.. Kay will check with the city regarding sign ordinance criteria. She will also talk with the high school shop teacher about the sign. By consensus the Board agreed to pursue options.

Pastor Chuck reported on the progress of work to revise the church by-laws. Kay read the recommended revisions regarding the responsibilities and duties of the Board of Trustees; by consensus the Board agreed to accept the recommended revisions of the By-laws regarding the Trustees.

Discussion regarding the Board of Trustees representative to the Church Council was entertained. The Church Council meets quarterly to share information between the various Boards and the church officers. Kay will be the representative from the Board of Trustees.

Pastor Chuck presented his reimbursement report. Motion to approve by Lyn, 2nd Dick. Motion approved.

Next meeting is May 14, 2024 at 5:30pm


Congregational concerns: Work at the Compassion Cupboard on April 30th from 9 am to noon. New bible study group to be starting up.
